- A seamless day of competitive action involving helicopters, Ribs and country sports set in the New Forest National Park and on the beautiful waters of the western Solent.
- In our high-speed Rib powerboats you will spend half a day blasting across the Solent in tight formation going from port to port for fiendish challenges as part of a Treasure Hunt, or to just enjoy the spectacle.
- Ashore, we have a selection of country sports ranging from adrenaline filled to cute and cuddly... From motorised buggies to clay pigeon shooting, archery to duck herding with gorgeous sheepdogs...
- For the grand finale jump into a helicopter for an aerial tour of that most famous of landmarks, the Needles, together with Hurst Castle, Alum Bay, the ancient port of Yarmouth and the castle guarding the harbour.
- Your day will start at The Haven bar & bistro in Lymington with a light breakfast. Both the 5 star Chewton Glenn and 4 star Rhinefield House Hotel have activity fields where we can land helicopters, where your day would finish with a Pimm's reception.
- This event can be run in rotations where your group is split into 3 teams and each team completes the land, sea or air activity before rotating to the next. But for the full experience your group tackles each challenge as a whole.



Indicative Itinerary

- We are happy to start the event whenever it suits. We are able to add in or subtract components to ensure a great event even if you want a late start and an early finish.
- Usually we find groups join us at 10.00 and expect to have finished their Pimms by 5.30
- Join us at The Haven bar & bistro for coffee, orange juice and a light breakfast
- Assemble to receive a full safety and event briefing
- Split into different teams and appoint team leaders
- Teams compete for points with medals for the winners
- Board the fleet of identical Ribs
- Enjoy some high speed close formation driving
- Plan your team's strategy with a little help from the skipper
- Stop in various ports and go ashore to complete the tasks using our iPads with fiendish treasure hunting software
- Expect to visit Yarmouth and Cowes on The Isle of Wight
- Enjoy lunch in the seafood restaurant overlooking the Solent
- Hop into a coach to the New Forest hotel (20 mins)
- Compete at our Country Sports mini-event
- Race the Rage Buggies around our precision driving course
- Have a shot at archery, air pistol, laser clay or clay pigeon shooting
- Herd the cute ducks and ducklings around the course using sheepdogs
- Try a wheelie in a hilarious Powerturn – vehicles with too much torque and two throttles!
- The helicopters arrive dramatically and land right next to your group
- Fly over the New Forest, Needles, Hurst Castle and Yarmouth Castle
- Enjoy a Pimms prize giving reception
