- Lysander has a variety of mingling areas besides the flybridge and saloon. A mizzen deck, aft deck with sofa, and substantial foredeck, create a feeling of space and comfort.
- The yacht is air-conditioned and fitted with wine cooler, ice maker, LCD TV's in every cabin and HiFi. Steel blue leather seats and cream woollen carpets personify the restrained and tasteful style.
- Don't be misled by the gilded specification; Lysander is no slouch. She reaches planing speeds very rapidly and remains at sea in conditions that leave 'plastic fantasies' behind.

## Lysander Itinerary

- Enjoy a full day on board Lysander. Raw power combines with sleek lines to make light work of even the choppiest sea.
- Arrive in the marina at a time to suit your party. We find most guests like to arrive between 09.30 and 11.00. Enjoy Danish pastries and bucks fizz on arrival; step aboard to meet the skipper and crew.
- The whole Solent is open for your exploration. Tour west to the Needles and beautiful western Solent, over to Cowes, the home of sailing, or east to the warships and Spinnaker Tower of Portsmouth.
- Our skipper will help you formulate a cruising plan taking into account the weather, tides, lunch plans and any interesting or unusual activity taking place in the Solent.
- Lunch is served at a carefully selected yacht club or waterside restaurant. We have excellent local knowledge and will recommend venues to suit desired taste, atmosphere and budget. Soft drinks, hot drinks and snacks are served throughout the day.
- Many chose to have a Rib accompany Lysander. Those who make the ship to ship transfer to the Rib are guaranteed an adrenaline high like no other! An excellent way of adding 'spice' to an already stunning day.
- We usually come off the water at 17.00 and have a drinks reception in a waterside bistro or yacht club to provide a perfect venue to run into an evening meal or BBQ if desired.
