- Although it is possible to start in Southampton, Portsmouth or Poole, Lymington is the favoured meeting point with plenty of free parking and an excellent bistro in the marina.
- Most guests arrive between 09.00 and 11.00. The day is yours though, there is nothing 'production line' about the day. Join us for as little as one hour or arrange a full day.
- Gather on the balcony of the Yacht Haven Bistro in Lymington, (or similar Solent venue), to enjoy coffee and bacon rolls whilst admiring the superb view of the Solent.
- Our skipper will help you formulate a cruising plan taking into account the weather, tides, lunch plans and any interesting or unusual activity taking place in the Solent.
- Lunch ashore at a carefully selected yacht club or waterside restaurant. We have excellent local knowledge and will be able to recommend venues to suit desired taste, atmosphere and budget.
- You might wish to add a highly competitive Rib Treasure Hunt to your day (particularly for groups of more than 14); it really is a fantastic enhancement to the day.
- There are no age limits. We have lifejackets to suit children of all ages. Talk to us about how we can configure the day to suit both the adrenaline junkies and those hoping for something more sedate.
- Most people are fairly exhausted by about 17.00; we usually have a drinks reception in a waterside bistro or yacht club to provide a perfect venue to continue entertaining and to go on to have an evening meal or BBQ if desired.
