- Powerboats with a 'flybridge' are the most versatile, particularly at major events. The flybridge provides outdoor seating for guests at the top of the boat's superstructure, offering a fantastic viewing platform.

- Arrive in the marina at a time to suit your party. We find most guests like to arrive between 09.30 and 11.00. Enjoy Danish pastries and bucks fizz on arrival; step aboard to meet the skipper and crew.
- The whole Solent is open for your exploration. Tour west to the Needles and beautiful western Solent, over to Cowes, the home of sailing, or east to the warships and Spinnaker Tower of Portsmouth.
- Our skipper will help you formulate a cruising plan taking into account the weather, tides, lunch plans and any interesting or unusual activity taking place in the Solent.
- Lunching aboard alongside at a marina is great fun, or lunch ashore at a carefully selected yacht club or waterside restaurant. Soft drinks, hot drinks and snacks are served throughout the day.
